An Act relating to motor vehicles; amending 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-903, which relates to negligent homicide; removing certain age limitation on offense; modifying reference; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 11-903, is amended to read as follows:

Section 11-903. ~~(a)~~ A. When the death of any person ensues within one (1) year as a proximate result of injury received by the driving of any vehicle by any person ~~sixteen (16) years of age or older~~ in reckless disregard of the safety of others, the person so operating such vehicle shall be guilty of negligent homicide.

~~(b)~~ B. Any person convicted of negligent homicide shall be punished by imprisonment in the county jail for not more than one (1) year or by fine of not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both such fine and imprisonment.

~~(c)~~ C. The Commissioner of Public Safety shall revoke the license or permit to drive and any nonresident operating privilege of any person convicted of negligent homicide.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
