An Act relating to militia; authorizing the Adjutant General to expend certain funds for certain purposes; stating qualifications of certain persons to receive certain benefit; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 77 of Title 44, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Adjutant General is hereby authorized to expend state funds specifically appropriated by the Legislature for payment/reimbursement of insurance premiums to provide coverage up to the amount of Two Hundred Fifty Thousand Dollars (\$250,000.00) under Serviceman's Group Life Insurance (SGLI) or State Sponsored Life Insurance (SSLI) for the military members of the Oklahoma Army and Air National Guard. Qualification for this insurance benefit is limited to military members of the Oklahoma Army and Air National

Guard who are in good standing in their unit and satisfactorily performing all required training.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
