WHEREAS, Atoka, Oklahoma, has many claims to fame, including the first Masonic Lodge and the first Catholic Church in Indian Territory. A stop on the Butterfield Overland Stage Route, U.S. Highway 69 passes through Atoka, Oklahoma, making it a familiar community for legions of truckers. As every country and western music fan knows, Reba McEntire is from the area; and

WHEREAS, on January 3, 2005, "USA Today" announced it was adding 41 cities to its weekday weather maps. Lawton, Oklahoma City, and Tulsa, Oklahoma, were already included on the map which gives forecasted high and low temperatures and precipitation. Indications were that one of the 41 selections would be another site in Oklahoma; and

WHEREAS, the "USA Today" new weather map site in Oklahoma, selected on January 10, 2005, was Atoka, Oklahoma, with a population under 3,000 and an average January temperature of 42.4 degrees.
