A Concurrent Resolution congratulating Jennifer Warren, Miss Oklahoma 2005; commending her abilities; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, graduating from Edmond North High School in 2001, Jennifer Warren was a member of the National Honor Society and active in Student Council, Fellowship of Christian Athletes, Spanish Club, and the Varsity Pom Squad. As a high school senior, she served as Captain of her State Championship Pom Squad. Jennifer received the Edmond Masonic Lodge "Student of Today" Award and was selected as Miss Edmond North in a selection process involving both students and faculty. In 2004 Jennifer Warren was inducted into the Edmond North High School Hall of Honor; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Warren began singing and dancing in junior high school. The Cheers and More All-Star Squad, of which she was a member, won two National Championships. As a freshman at the University of Central Oklahoma (UCO), her dance squad placed second at the National Dancers Association National Championships; and in 2003 the squad brought the National Championship to UCO; and

WHEREAS, Jennifer Warren, R.N., is a nursing graduate of the University of Central Oklahoma. She received the Evelyn Hamil Award, a senior leadership award given by the Nursing Department faculty. A member of Sigma Theta Tau, the nursing honor society, Jennifer was active in the UCO Student Nursing Association, served as a member of the Leadership Council, as Junior Class Historian, and as Public Relations Officer. She was listed on the Dean's Honor Roll four years. She was also a member of the National Student

Nurses' Association and made the National Dean's Honor Roll list;

WHEREAS, as a second-generation nurse who has assisted in the deliveries of babies to Oklahoma teenagers, Jennifer's chosen cause is the reduction of teen pregnancies. Representing her school as Miss UCO in the Miss Oklahoma Pageant in 2004, Jennifer won many awards and placed fourth. In 2005 when she competed as Miss Green Country, Jennifer also received honors including first runner-up to Miss Oklahoma. When her predecessor, Jennifer Berry, was selected as Miss America, Jennifer Warren assumed the title as Miss Oklahoma 2005.
