A Resolution congratulating The University of Tulsa Golden Hurricane softball team for winning its first Conference USA tournament title and first trip to the NCAA Championship; commending The University of Tulsa Golden Hurricane softball team for its competitive spirit playing in the NCAA Regional; and directing distribution.

WHEREAS, The University of Tulsa Golden Hurricane softball team defeated the Marshall Thundering Herd on May 13, 2006, to win its first Conference USA Softball Championship. By defeating third-seeded Houston earlier in the day, the top-seeded Golden Hurricane earned the right to again face the Herd in the final game of the tournament; and

WHEREAS, The University of Tulsa Golden Hurricane softball team played against the Stanford Cardinal in the first round of the NCAA Region VI Tournament in Fresno, California. The University of Tulsa, however, lost to Stanford and Cal State Fullerton, thus ending the Golden Hurricane's season with a 34-24 record; and

WHEREAS, Senior Katie Torres and sophomore Sarah Dyer were first-team all-conference performers, while senior Julie Shafer was named to the all-conference second team and freshmen Brooke Smart and Jessica Barr were selected to the C-USA all-freshman team.
