WHEREAS, the greatness of the State of Oklahoma is founded upon

WHEREAS, one of Oklahoma's finest, Ronald James Henderson was
first employed by the Oklahoma State Senate on September 6, 1984.
While working at the Senate, he attended Rose State College in
Midwest City, graduating with an associate's degree in law
enforcement in 1987, and then attended Central State University in
Edmond, graduating with a bachelor of arts degree in criminal
justice in 1991; and

WHEREAS, Ron joined the Senate Committee Staff as a legislative
analyst on March 1, 1992. Most recently, he has served as the
legislative analyst for the Senate Committee on Transportation and
the Senate Committee on Tourism and Wildlife. One of Ron's most
recent assignments at the Senate was as legislative analyst for the
Senate Committee on Veterans and Military Affairs, a position he was
particularly proud of due to his commitment to veterans' issues,
which he both understood and sympathized with due to his
distinguished service in the United States Army from December of
1976 to June of 1983; and

WHEREAS, the Oklahoma State Senate, its members and its staff
have benefited immeasurably from Ron's qualities of compassion,

kindness, humility, meekness and patience, his warmth and humor, his passion for the Oklahoma Sooners and the Dallas Cowboys football teams, and most of all, his dedication to service: to his family, to his country and state, to the Oklahoma State Senate, and to God.
