Mr./Madame President:

I move to amend the Floor Substitute for Senate Bill No. 1397, Page 2, Line 28 and 1/2,

By inserting the following language:

“10. “Eucha-Spavinaw Phosphorus Index (ESPI)” means a risk assessment tool for phosphorus runoff potential from individual fields within a watershed. Parameters which influence phosphorus availability, retention, management, movement and uptake are included in the phosphorus index (PI). Fields having low or high phosphorus runoff potential may be identified through the use of the Phosphorus Index and may be prioritized for nutrient application and soil management practices. Eight site characteristics are included in the ESPI, grouped into the phosphorus source and phosphorus transport categories. The factors are:

- a. soil test phosphorus,
- b. soluble phosphorus application rate,
- c. soil erosion,
- d. method of phosphorus application,
- e. soil runoff class,
- f. flooding frequency,
- g. timing of phosphorus application, and
- h. grazing management.

The ESPI shall govern the terms and conditions under which any poultry litter or other nutrients may be land applied in the Eucha-Spavinaw watershed;”

And by renumbering subsequent paragraphs; and

On page 13, lines 3-10 by deleting all language and inserting the following language:

“d. the Eucha-Spavinaw Phosphorus Index (ESPI) shall be adopted by the Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry to govern the application of poultry litter and nutrients within the Eucha-Spavinaw watershed, provided that the Department shall through its jurisdiction retain authority to amend the ESPI as necessary to ensure maintenance and protection of water quality.”;
