FLOOR SUBSTITUTE

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Historical Society; making appropriations to the Oklahoma Historical Society; stating purposes; making appropriations nonfiscal; making appropriations exempt from certain agency category and budget limits; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Six Hundred Fifty-four Thousand Five Hundred Thirteen Dollars (\$654,513.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to make debt service payments on obligations issued to provide financing for construction of a History Center for the Oklahoma Historical Society.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Historical Society from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the Special Cash Fund of the State Treasury, the sum of Two Hundred Forty-nine Thousand Four Hundred Eighty-seven Dollars (\$249,487.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Historical Society by law.

SECTION 3. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year limitations and shall be available for

encumbrance and expenditure purposes for a period of thirty (30) months from the date this act is approved.

SECTION 4. The appropriations made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal years 2005 and 2006 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 5. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
