Mr./Madame President:

I move to amend Senate Bill No. 1825, Page 2, Line 71/2,
as follows:

By inserting a new SECTION 2 to read as follows, by renumbering subsequent sections, and by amending the title to conform.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 109 of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Upon the death of any person caused by another person driving under the influence of an intoxicant on the public roads or highways of this state, the Department of Transportation is hereby authorized at the request of a purchaser to issue a plaque memorializing the deceased with the name of the deceased conspicuous in size to be placed at the site where the death occurred for a period not to exceed four (4) years. Upon receipt of payment, the Department shall be responsible for the placement and removal of the plaque. The Department shall promulgate rules necessary to implement the purpose and objective of this section.
