[state government - Department of Central Services -
vendor notification - Oklahoma Bid Assistance Network
- codification - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 85.7e of Title 74, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. A state agency shall notify all vendors listed under the
appropriate commodity classification on the Department of Central
Services vendor registration supplier list if the amount of the bid
solicitation is greater than Ten Thousand Dollars (\$10,000.00).

B. A state agency shall submit to the Department of Central
Services, Central Purchasing Division, copies of any bid
solicitations to be placed on the Department of Central Services bid
notification web site if the amount of the bid solicitation is
greater than Two Thousand Five Hundred Dollars (\$2,500.00).

C. The Department of Central Services shall coordinate with the
Oklahoma Department of Career and Technology Education and with
local chambers of commerce to provide information necessary to
educate and inform local vendors about the procedures and methods to
bid on solicitations by state entities. The Oklahoma Department of
Career and Technology Education shall provide such information from

the Department of Central Services in an electronic format on the Oklahoma Bid Assistance Network.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
