COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1232 - By: BENGE
of the House and BRODGON of the Senate.

[Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration
Commission - codification - effective date -
emergency]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.7 of Title 73, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. Neither the State of Oklahoma nor the Oklahoma Capitol
Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission shall become
obligated, by contract or otherwise, for an operational expense
associated with any project related to the recognition or
celebration of the Oklahoma Centennial.

B. As used in this section, "operational expense" means:

1. Wages or salary to be paid to any employee;
2. Utility costs;
3. Insurance; or
4. Any other recurring cost or payment of any kind related to a
location, site, exhibit, structure, object or personal property

1 acquired, constructed or maintained as part of the recognition of
2 the Oklahoma Centennial or its celebration.

3 C. No monies from the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
4 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund shall be used in payment of
5 any expense prohibited by the provisions of this section.

6 D. As used in this section, "operational expense" shall not
7 include any debt or interest thereon obligated prior to the
8 effective date of this act.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

10 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
