House Bill No. 1310

COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1310 - By:
SMITHSON and McMULLEN of the House and CORN and LAUGHLIN of the
Senate.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating
certain bridge as the Rider Daugherty Memorial Bridge;
designating a portion of State Highway 54 as the Luke James
Memorial Highway; designating a portion of State Highway 54
as the Jack Begley Memorial Highway; designating a portion
of State Highway 64 as the Lyle Rymer Highway; designating a
bypass on State Highway 81 as the Bobby Green Memorial
Expressway; designating a portion of State Highway 81 as the
Veterans Memorial Highway; directing placement of markers;
providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge crossing Little Lee Creek, which is located on State
Highway 101, shall be designated as the "Rider Daugherty Memorial
Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable
permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1675 of Title 69, unless there
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The section of State Highway 54 extending from the municipal
2 limits of Optima to the Kansas state line shall be designated as the
3 "Luke James Memorial Highway". The Department of Transportation
4 shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon that
5 section of highway bearing that name.

6 SECTION 3. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1676 of Title 69, unless there
8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 The section of State Highway 54 that extends from the Texas
10 state line, near Texhoma, to the municipal limits of Optima shall be
11 designated as the "Jack Begley Memorial Highway". The Department of
12 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
13 on that section of highway bearing that name.

14 SECTION 4. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
15 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1677 of Title 69, unless there
16 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

17 State Highway 64 in Roland, Oklahoma, between PawPaw Road and
18 Cottonwood Road shall be designated as the "Lyle Rymer Highway".
19 The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent
20 markers to be placed upon the highway bearing that name.

21 SECTION 5. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
22 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1678 of Title 69, unless there
23 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

1 The bypass located on State Highway 81 in Duncan shall be
2 designated as the "Bobby Green Memorial Expressway". The Department
3 of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be
4 placed upon the bypass bearing that name.

5 SECTION 6. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
6 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1679 of Title 69, unless there
7 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

8 State Highway 81 between Duncan and Comanche shall be designated
9 as the "Veterans Memorial Highway". The Department of
10 Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed
11 upon the highway bearing that name.

12 SECTION 7. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
