7 COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1360 - By: CASE of  
8 the House and MONSON of the Senate.

9 [ motor vehicles - used motor vehicle and parts dealers -  
10 fees - effective date ]

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 47 O.S. 2001, Section 591.5, is  
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 591.5 An application for a license shall be accompanied  
15 by the following fees:

16 1. Two Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) for an initial license for an  
17 applicant's established principal place of business, One Hundred  
18 Dollars (\$100.00) for a renewal license for an applicant's  
19 established place of business and Fifty dollars (\$50.00) for each  
20 additional place of business, if any, to which the application  
21 pertains; provided, if an applicant holds a used motor vehicle  
22 dealer's license issued pursuant to paragraph 1 of subsection C of  
23 Section 583 of this title, for an applicant's established place of  
24 business the initial license fee shall be One Hundred Dollars

1 (\$100.00) and the renewal fee shall be Seventy-five Dollars  
2 (\$75.00); provided further, if an applicant is applying  
3 simultaneously for a license under this paragraph and under  
4 paragraph 1 of subsection C of Section 583 of this title, the  
5 initial application fee shall be One Hundred Fifty Dollars  
6 (\$150.00). If an applicant for or holder of a used motor vehicle  
7 dealer's license also applies for a rebuilder certificate, the  
8 initial fee for the certificate shall be ~~Fifty Dollars (\$50.00)~~ Two  
9 Hundred Dollars (\$200.00) and the renewal fee shall be ~~Twenty-five~~  
10 ~~Dollars (\$25.00)~~ One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00). The Oklahoma Used  
11 Motor Vehicle and Parts Commission shall issue a buyer's  
12 identification card (B.I.D.) with each certificate issued. License  
13 fees shall be returnable only in the event that the application is  
14 denied by the Commission.

15 2. Any change which renders no longer accurate any information  
16 contained in an application for a license filed with the Commission  
17 shall be amended within thirty (30) days after the occurrence of the  
18 change on a form prescribed by the Commission by rule, accompanied  
19 by a fee of Two Dollars (\$2.00) plus Five Dollars (\$5.00) for each  
20 additional place of business, if any. If an amended application is  
21 made after July 1 of any year, the filing fee shall be Two Dollars  
22 (\$2.00) plus Three Dollars (\$3.00) for each additional place of  
23 business, if any.

1           3. Every license issued to an automobile dismantler and parts  
2   recycler shall expire on December 31 of each year and shall be  
3   renewed on or before January 1 of the following year.

4           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
