ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 1762 - By: SWEEDEN and AUFFET of the House and WILSON and HARRISON of the Senate.

An Act relating to state emblems; making the strawberry the official fruit of the State of Oklahoma; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 98.8 of Title 25, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The strawberry is hereby designated and adopted as the official fruit of the State of Oklahoma.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
