10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 4260 of Title 74, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 A. It shall be unlawful for any person to **accept** any
15 contribution, as defined in Rule 257:1-1-2 of the Ethics Commission,
16 in a facility ordinarily used for the conduct of state government
17 business.

18 B. Any person who willfully violates any provision of this
19 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and, upon conviction
20 thereof, shall be punished by a fine of not less than Fifty Dollars
21 (\$50.00) nor more than One Thousand Dollars (\$1,000.00), or by
22 imprisonment for not longer than six (6) months or by both such fine
23 and imprisonment and, upon conviction, shall be ineligible for
24 appointment to or employment in a position in state service and, if

1 at the time of conviction is an employee of the state, shall forfeit
2 his or her position.

3 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
