House Bill No. 2363

ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2363 - By: BANZ of the House and RILEY of the Senate.

An Act relating to schools; amending 70 O.S. 2001, Section 8-103.2, which relates to education transfers; modifying extramural athletic competition eligibility requirements; allowing the transfer of students whose parents or legal guardians are teachers; providing for codification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 70 O.S. 2001, Section 8-103.2, is amended to read as follows:

Section 8-103.2 Except as otherwise provided, a student who enrolls, pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act or pursuant to Section 2 of this act, in a school district in which the student is not a resident shall not be eligible to participate in school-related extramural athletic competition governed by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association for a period of one (1) year from the first day of attendance at the receiving school unless the transfer is from a school district which does not offer the grade the student is entitled to pursue. If the student is granted an emergency transfer pursuant to Section 8-104 of this title, was granted a transfer for any reason prior to January 1, 2000, or

1 enrolls pursuant to the Education Open Transfer Act and qualifies  
2 for a hardship waiver pursuant to the rules of the Oklahoma  
3 Secondary School Activities Association, eligibility to participate  
4 in school-related extramural athletic competition shall be  
5 determined by the Oklahoma Secondary School Activities Association.

6 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
7 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 8-113 of Title 70, unless there  
8 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

9 A student shall be allowed to transfer to a school district in  
10 which the parent or legal guardian of the student is employed as a  
11 teacher, as defined in Section 1-116 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma  
12 Statutes, upon the approval of the receiving district only.

13 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

14 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
15 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
16 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
17 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
