ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2373 - By: NEWPORT, DANK, DORMAN and DUNCAN  
of the House and MYERS of the Senate.

[ revenue and taxation - income tax checkoff - Revolving  
Fund - codification - effective date ]

~~BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:~~

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2368.15 of Title 68, unless  
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission shall include on each state  
individual tax return form for tax years beginning after December  
31, 2006, and each state corporate tax return form for tax years  
beginning after December 31, 2006, an opportunity for the taxpayer  
to donate from a tax refund for the benefit of the Oklahoma Leukemia  
and Lymphoma Revolving Fund.

B. All monies generated from donations made pursuant to  
subsection A of this section shall be paid to the State Treasurer by  
the Oklahoma Tax Commission and placed to the credit of the Oklahoma  
Leukemia and Lymphoma Revolving Fund created in subsection D of this  
section.

1 C. The monies generated from donations made pursuant to  
2 subsection A of this section shall be used by the State Department  
3 of Health for the purpose supporting voluntary health agencies  
4 dedicated to curing leukemia, lymphoma, Hodgkin's disease, and  
5 myeloma, and to improving the quality of life of patients and their  
6 families.

7 D. 1. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a  
8 revolving fund for the State Department of Health to be designated  
9 the "Oklahoma Leukemia and Lymphoma Revolving Fund". The fund shall  
10 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and  
11 shall consist of all monies received by the State Department of  
12 Health as designated by subsection C of this section.

13 2. All monies accruing to the credit of said fund are hereby  
14 appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the State  
15 Department of Health for the purpose specified in subsection C of  
16 this act.

17 3. Expenditures from said fund shall be made upon warrants  
18 issued by the State Treasurer against claims filed as prescribed by  
19 law with the Director of State Finance for approval and payment.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
