ENGROSSED HOUSE BILL NO. 2634 - By: BALKMAN of the House and LAMB of the Senate.

[ state government - Paperwork Reduction Act of 2006 -

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9050 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

This act shall be known and may be cited as the "Paperwork Reduction Act of 2006".

SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 9050.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

Each agency, as defined by paragraph 3 of Section 250.3 of Title 75 of the Oklahoma Statutes, with the exception of the State Board of Education, shall eliminate, reduce, consolidate, and simplify the number, type, and length of reports, data, statistics, and other information required of any other agency, political subdivision, or individual by the agency.

1 SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

2 SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
