SENATE BILL NO. 1005 - By: CAIN of the Senate and STEELE of the House.

[public health and safety - promulgation of rules - pilot program - effective date]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1-890.2a of Title 63, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Health Care Authority Board and the State Board of Health shall promulgate rules and standards for a pilot Medicaid reimbursement program for assisted living services for two hundred (200) low-income, elderly Medicaid recipients. Such services shall be provided to recipients who would otherwise be referred for nursing home care.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
