SENATE BILL NO. 1006 - By: GUMM of the Senate and ROAN of the House.

[ economic development - specifying duties - Oklahoma  
Department of Commerce - gunsmith curriculum - effective  
date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 3613 of Title 68, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. The Oklahoma Department of Commerce shall collaborate with  
an Oklahoma institution of higher education that offers a gunsmith  
curriculum to develop strategies to attract a firearms manufacturer  
to locate in close proximity to such institution.

B. Such institution of higher education shall designate a  
liaison with the Oklahoma Department of Commerce to coordinate said  
efforts.

C. It is the finding of the Oklahoma Legislature that the  
manufacturing of firearms is a manufacturing activity classified in  
the North American Industry Classification System (NAICS) Manual  
under Industry Sector Number 33, as defined in Section 3603 et seq.  
of Title 68 of the Oklahoma Statutes, and therefore qualifies for

1 certain economic incentives. It is the intent of the Oklahoma  
2 Legislature that the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and other  
3 agencies of this state with the responsibility of recruiting or  
4 assisting in the recruitment of businesses actively promote the use  
5 of existing economic incentives to be extended to firearms  
6 manufacturers as inducement to relocate to Oklahoma.

7 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
