5 SENATE BILL NO. 1034 - By: RILEY of the Senate and PETERS of the  
6 House.

7 [ public finance - state agencies - toll free telephones -  
8 effective date ]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 62 O.S. 2001, Section 41.5j, is  
11 amended to read as follows:

12 Section 41.5j A. No agency of the executive branch of the  
13 state shall use state funds for or enter into any agreement for the  
14 acquisition, development or enhancement of a communication or  
15 telecommunication system including voice, data, radio, video and  
16 facsimile systems, without written authorization of the Director of  
17 State Finance. The Director of State Finance shall verify that any  
18 such acquisition, development or enhancement is compatible with the  
19 operation of the Oklahoma Government Telecommunications Network  
20 created in Section 41.5m of this title.

21 B. Not later than September 1 of each year, all agencies of the  
22 state presently using or contemplating the use of voice, data,  
23 radio, video and facsimile communication or telecommunication  
24 systems shall submit to the Information Services Division of the

1 Office of State Finance a long-range plan summarizing the agency's  
2 detailed plan, for not less than the current fiscal year and the  
3 ensuing three (3) fiscal years. Agencies may submit to the  
4 Information Services Division of the Office of State Finance  
5 revisions or amendments to its long-range plan as deemed necessary  
6 by the agencies. The plan shall include at a minimum:

7 1. An inventory of communication or telecommunication equipment  
8 owned, leased or rented for use in all communication services for  
9 state government, including communication services provided as part  
10 of any other total system to be used by the state or any of its  
11 agencies;

12 2. Current budget plans, expenditures and resources necessary  
13 to operate any and all systems included in the above inventory;

14 3. Major development projects proposed for the current fiscal  
15 year and the next three (3) fiscal years and the anticipated results  
16 and benefits to be achieved;

17 4. An explanation of revisions to previous plans;

18 5. Key project dates; and

19 6. Specific segments which will be included in the agency  
20 budget request for the ensuing fiscal year.

21 C. No agency of the executive branch of the state shall enter  
22 into any agreement for the acquisition, development or enhancement  
23 of a communication or telecommunication system or service including

1 voice, data, radio, video and facsimile systems, unless the cost of  
2 such addition, change, improvement or development has been included  
3 in the statewide communications plan of the Information Services  
4 Division, as said plan may have been amended or revised.

5 D. State agencies may enter into interagency contracts to share  
6 communications and telecommunications resources for mutually  
7 beneficial purposes. The contract shall clearly state how its  
8 purpose contributes to the development or enhancement or cost  
9 reduction of a state network which includes voice, data, radio,  
10 video or facsimile systems. The contract shall be approved by the  
11 Information Services Division before any payments are made.

12 E. Effective November 1, 2006, each state agency shall provide  
13 a toll-free telephone number in order to conduct official business  
14 of the agency.

15 F. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the  
16 telecommunications network known as OneNet whether said network is  
17 governed or operated by the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher  
18 Education or any other state entity assigned responsibility for  
19 OneNet.

20 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
