COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1043 - By: BROGDON of the Senate and SMALIGO of the House.

[ cities and towns - enact certain ordinances - effective date ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 14-107.1 of Title 11, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. If a municipal governing body enacts or adopts by reference ordinances which are compilations or codes of law or regulations relating to plumbing, mechanical and electrical installations, or any other matters which the municipality has the power to regulate, such ordinances are not required to be published in full. Legal publication of such ordinances may be by publishing the title and a summary of their contents as provided by Section 14-106 of this title. At least one copy of such ordinances shall be kept in the office of the municipal clerk for public use, inspection, and examination. The municipal clerk shall keep copies of the ordinances for distribution or sale at a reasonable price.

1           B. A municipality which adopts trade building standards shall  
2 adopt and enforce the building code as last adopted by the  
3 Construction Industries Board; provided, however, municipalities may  
4 make amendments to the building code to enforce stricter measures.

5           C. A municipality which adopts the building code as last  
6 adopted by the Construction Industries Board shall comply with the  
7 revised building code within two cycles of the Board's adoption of  
8 the revised building code.

9           D. Ordinances which are passed by the governing body with an  
10 emergency clause attached are not required to be published in full,  
11 but may be published by title only in the manner provided by Section  
12 14-106 of this title.

13           SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
