SENATE BILL NO. 1300 - By: SHURDEN of the Senate and TURNER of the House.

[ game and fish - special use permits - effective date - emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 130, O.S.L. 2002 (29 O.S. Supp. 2005, Section 4-138), is amended to read as follows:

Section 4-138. A. The Wildlife Conservation Commission may establish a special use permit to be designated the "Blue River Conservation Passport". The Passport shall be required of all persons not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection C D of this section, who enter or use the Blue River Public Fishing and Hunting Area.

B. The Commission may establish and assess an annual fee of not more than One Dollar (\$1.00) above the cost of an annual resident fishing license for the Passport. Each person, not otherwise exempt as provided for in subsection C D of this section, entering or using the Blue River Public Fishing and Hunting Area shall be required to have a Passport in their possession while in the area.

1       C. 1. The Wildlife Conservation Commission shall require all  
2 persons who use land owned and designated by the Wildlife  
3 Conservation Commission as Wildlife Management Areas or Department  
4 of Wildlife Conservation fishing areas to purchase a hunting or  
5 fishing license whether or not they are hunting or fishing. These  
6 licenses shall be required of all persons not otherwise exempt as  
7 provided for in subsection D of this section, who enter or use any  
8 Wildlife Management Areas or Department fishing areas.

9       2 Persons entering but not hunting or fishing on the following  
10 Department fishing areas are exempt from the requirements of this  
11 paragraph:

- 12           a. Etling,
- 13           b. Raymond Gary,
- 14           c. Watonga, and
- 15           d. Blue River Public Fishing and Hunting Area.

16       D. The following persons shall be exempt from the Passport  
17 requirements of this section:

18       1. All persons who possess a valid Oklahoma annual or  
19 combination resident fishing or hunting license, an annual  
20 nonresident fishing or hunting license, a lifetime resident or  
21 nonresident fishing, hunting, or combination license, a senior  
22 citizen fishing or hunting license, or a disability fishing or  
23 hunting license;
