5 SENATE BILL NO. 1336 - By: BASS and WYRICK of the Senate and COODY
6 of the House.

7 [elections - compensation of election board secretaries -
8 counting voters - effective date]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 26 O.S. 2001, Section 2-118, as
11 last amended by Section 5, Chapter 248, O.S.L. 2005 (26 O.S. Supp.
12 2005, Section 2-118), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 2-118. A. The secretary of each county election board
14 shall be paid an annual salary to be determined by the following
15 schedule. However, the salary of a county election board secretary
16 shall not fall below the level of the April 30, 2003, salary, and
17 the salary of any person who is reappointed to the position of
18 county election board secretary shall not fall below the salary
19 received in the immediately preceding term, regardless of the number
20 of active registered voters in the county. A county election board
21 secretary serving on April 30, 2004, shall not receive a salary
22 increase if said secretary is paid an amount greater than the salary
23 indicated in this section according to the number of registered
24 voters in said county. A county election board secretary shall not

1 receive a salary increase while the county is under the
2 administrative supervision of the State Election Board.

3 Beginning May 1, 2003, the annual salary, payable monthly shall
4 be:

5	Registered Voters	Salary
6	0 to 10,000	\$ \$21,588.28
7	10,001 to 15,000	\$ \$22,388.28
8	15,001 to 17,500	\$ \$26,252.45
9	17,501 to 25,000	\$ \$29,429.93
10	25,001 to 50,000	\$ \$35,846.94
11	50,001 to 75,000	\$ \$45,174.66
12	75,001 to 150,000	\$ \$50,611.26
13	150,001 or more	\$ \$56,043.00

14 B. The salary and fringe benefits paid to each secretary shall
15 be paid from county funds on a monthly basis and shall be reimbursed
16 from funds appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose at a
17 rate of not to exceed one hundred thirty-five percent (135%) of the
18 above-specified salaries. Claims for said reimbursement shall be
19 filed according to procedures prescribed by the Secretary of the
20 State Election Board and approved by the Director of State Finance.
21 Said claims for reimbursement shall only be paid for actual
22 expenditures made by the county. The number of registered voters,
23 for the purposes of this section, shall be determined by the number

1 of registered voters, ~~excluding~~ including active and inactive
2 voters, in the county on January 1, 1979, and every two (2) years
3 thereafter.

4 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
