[ Oklahoma Tourism and Parks and Recreation Enhancement Act  
- severance package - employment opportunities -  
codification -  
emergency ]

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 2242.1 of Title 74, unless there  
is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department is hereby  
directed to develop a severance package for all unclassified  
employees of the Department affected by the closure of any state  
park facility operated by the Department. Each unclassified  
employee at any state park facility must have a minimum of two (2)  
years' continuous service with the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation  
Department at such state park facility on the date of closure of the  
facility and shall have the opportunity to obtain employment with  
any successor operator of a resort or park facility located on the  
lands held by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department,

1 provided the employee is qualified and eligible for any such  
2 employment.

3 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
4 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
5 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
6 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
