7 [ **public finance - Military Department Emergency Response**  
8 **Revolving Fund - appropriation - effective date -**

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified  
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 47 of Title 62, unless there is  
13 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving fund  
15 for the Military Department to be designated the "Military  
16 Department Emergency Response Revolving Fund". The fund shall be a  
17 continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall  
18 consist of all monies for emergency response teams received by the  
19 Military Department from the Legislature. All monies accruing to  
20 the credit of said fund are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted  
21 and expended by the Military Department for the purpose of providing  
22 emergency response teams to disaster areas. Expenditures from said  
23 fund shall be made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer  
24 against claims filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State  
25 Finance for approval and payment.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
