COMMITTEE SUBSTITUTE FOR SENATE BILL NO. 1459 - By: CAIN and JOHNSON

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 24-100b of Title 70, unless
there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

A. In order to assist the Healthy and Fit School Advisory
Committees created pursuant to Section 24-100a of Title 70 of the
Oklahoma Statutes, the State Department of Education in consultation
with the State Department of Health shall make available to schools
information and technical assistance for use in:

- 1. Establishing healthy school nutrition environments;
- 2. Reducing childhood obesity;
- 3. Development of quality physical education and activity
programs;
- 4. Prevention of diet-related chronic diseases; and
- 5. Establishing, implementing, and evaluating school wellness
policies.

1 B. The Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committees are
2 encouraged to utilize the School Health Index available on the
3 Centers for Disease Control and Prevention website or the Oklahoma
4 Healthy and Fit Schools Scorecard available on the Governor's
5 Council on Physical Fitness and Sports website as a program
6 assessment and monitoring instrument.

7 C. The Healthy and Fit School Advisory Committees shall be
8 involved in the monitoring, implementation, and evaluation of
9 Section 5-147 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes, which limits
10 access to foods of minimal nutritional value.

11 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
