7 [motor vehicles - creating special license plate - March of
8 Dimes - effective date]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 14, Chapter 504, O.S.L.
11 2004, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 416, O.S.L. 2005 (47 O.S.
12 Supp. 2005, Section 1135.5), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 1135.5 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby
14 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license
15 plates to persons wishing to demonstrate support and provide
16 financial assistance as provided by this section.

17 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other
18 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of
19 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used
20 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been
21 registered for the current year with a motor license agent.

22 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax
23 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall
24 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.

1 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain
2 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor
3 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be
4 issued on a staggered system.

5 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a
6 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept
7 applications for special license plates authorized under this
8 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's
9 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount
10 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary
11 information directly into such system and generate a receipt
12 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents
13 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of this title for
14 registration of a motor vehicle. The motor license agent fees for
15 acceptance of applications and renewals shall be paid out of the
16 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund.

17 If fewer than one hundred of any type of special license plates
18 authorized prior to January 1, 2004, are issued prior to January 1,
19 2006, the Tax Commission shall discontinue issuance and renewal of
20 that type of special license plate. Any such authorized special
21 license plate registrant shall be allowed to display the license
22 plate upon the designated vehicle until the registration expiration

1 date. After such time the expired special license plate shall be
2 removed from the vehicle.

3 For special license plates authorized on or after July 1, 2004,
4 no special license plates shall be developed or issued by the Tax
5 Commission until the Commission receives one hundred prepaid
6 applications therefore. The prepaid applications must be received
7 by the Tax Commission within one hundred and eighty (180) days of
8 the effective date of the authorization or the authority to issue
9 shall be null and void. In the event one hundred prepaid
10 applications are not received by the Tax Commission within such
11 prescribed time period any payment so received shall be refunded
12 accordingly.

13 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as
14 follows:

15 1. University or College Supporter License Plates - such plates
16 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support to any state-supported or private university or college. As
18 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
19 apportioned as provided in Section 1104.1 of this title;

20 2. Environmental Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
22 Commission by the Department of Environmental Quality in
23 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any

1 person wishing to demonstrate support to implement the statewide
2 general public environmental education program created pursuant to
3 the provisions of the Oklahoma Environmental Quality Code. Such
4 plates shall be designed and issued to any person in any combination
5 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
6 personalized license plates. A dealer's license plate issued
7 pursuant to Section 1116.1 or 1128 of this title may be designated
8 an Environmental Awareness License Plate upon payment of the fee
9 imposed by this section and any other registration fees required by
10 the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. As provided in
11 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned
12 pursuant to Section 1104.2 of this title;

13 3. Firefighter License Plates - such plates shall be designed
14 for any career or retired firefighter, volunteer or paid.
15 Firefighters may apply for firefighter plates for up to four
16 vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a
17 motorcycle upon proof of a fire department membership by either an
18 identification card or letter from the chief of the fire department.
19 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
20 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
21 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
22 deceased firefighter, if the spouse has not since remarried, may
23 apply for a firefighter license plate for one vehicle with a rated

1 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less or for a motorcycle upon
2 proof that the deceased firefighter was a member of a fire
3 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief
4 of the fire department.

5 Except for motorcycles, the license plate shall have the legend
6 "Oklahoma" in the color Pantone 186C Red and shall contain no more
7 than three letters and three numbers in the color Pantone 301C Blue.
8 Between the letters and numbers shall be the Firefighter Maltese
9 Cross Logo in the color Pantone 186C Red outlined in the color
10 Pantone 301C Blue. Below the letters and the logo shall be the word
11 "Firefighter" in the color Pantone 186C Red. The license plate for
12 motorcycles may be of a similar design as space permits or a new
13 design in order to meet the space requirements of a motorcycle
14 license plate. The plates shall not be subject to the design
15 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other
16 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each
17 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue.

18 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
19 shall be deposited to the Oklahoma State Firemen's Museum Building &
20 Memorial Fund for support of the Oklahoma Firefighter Fallen and
21 Living Memorial;

22 4. Wildlife Conservation License Plates - such plates shall be
23 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission by the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation in
2 consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for wildlife conservation in
4 this state through the Wildlife Diversity Fund, provided for in
5 Section 3-310 of Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes. Such plates may
6 be designed and issued to any person as for personalized license
7 plates.

8 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
9 shall be apportioned pursuant to subsection D of Section 3-310 of
10 Title 29 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

11 5. Child Abuse Prevention License Plates - such plates shall be
12 designed, subject to the criteria to be presented to the Tax
13 Commission by the Office of Child Abuse Prevention in the State
14 Department of Health and the Oklahoma Committee to Prevent Child
15 Abuse, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
16 the prevention of child abuse.

17 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
18 shall be deposited in the Child Abuse Prevention Fund;

19 6. United States Olympic Committee Supporter License Plates -
20 such plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
21 demonstrate support for the United States Olympic Committee. The
22 plates shall be issued to any person in any combination of numbers
23 and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized

1 license plates. The plate shall contain the official United States
2 Olympic Committee logo. The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if
3 necessary, to enter into a licensing agreement with the United
4 States Olympic Committee for any licensing fees which may be
5 required in order to use the United States Olympic Committee logo or
6 design. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment of not
7 more than Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) for each license plate
8 issued;

9 7. Oklahoma History License Plates - such plates shall be
10 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate interest in
11 Oklahoma history. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
12 collected shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Historical Society
13 Revolving Fund to be used for educational purposes;

14 8. Historic Route 66 License Plates - such plates shall be
15 designed to honor historic Route 66, also known as the "Mother
16 Road". As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
17 shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma Historical Society Revolving
18 Fund to be distributed to the Route 66 Museum located in Clinton,
19 Oklahoma;

20 9. Heart of the Heartland License Plates - such plates shall be
21 designed and issued to any person wishing to honor the victims of
22 the terrorist bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal
23 Building in downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995. As provided

1 in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited
2 in the Heart of the Heartland Scholarship Fund, as established in
3 Section 2282 of Title 70 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

4 10. Emergency Medical Technician License Plates - such plates
5 shall be designed and issued to any person who is an emergency
6 medical technician. Such persons may apply for an emergency medical
7 technician license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying
8 capacity of one (1) ton or less upon proof of an emergency medical
9 technician's license. The license plate shall be designed in
10 consultation with the state association of emergency medical
11 technicians. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee
12 collected shall be apportioned to the county of residence of the
13 person purchasing the plates to be equally apportioned by the county
14 to the city and county volunteer fire departments in the county;

15 11. Fight Breast Cancer License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed to demonstrate support for the prevention and treatment of
17 breast cancer in this state. As provided in this section, an amount
18 of the fee collected shall be apportioned to the Breast Cancer Act
19 Revolving Fund;

20 12. Crime Victims Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
21 be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
22 awareness of and support for victims of crimes. The license plates
23 shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Crime Victims

1 Centre. As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected
2 shall be apportioned to the Attorney General's Revolving Fund for
3 the Office of the Attorney General, which is hereby directed to use
4 such funds to contract with a statewide nonprofit organization to
5 provide services to crime victims;

6 13. Oklahoma Safe Kids Association License Plates - such plates
7 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
8 support and awareness of the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association. The
9 license plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
10 Safe Kids Association. As provided in this section, an amount of
11 the fee collected shall be deposited in the Children's Hospital -
12 Oklahoma Safe Kids Association Revolving Fund to be distributed to
13 the Oklahoma Safe Kids Association program;

14 14. Four-H Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
15 subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission by the
16 Four-H Foundation, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
17 support of the Four-H Club. Such plates may be designed and issued
18 to any person as for personalized license plates. As provided in
19 this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned to
20 the OSU Extension Service License Plate Revolving Fund created in
21 Section 1104.4 of this title;

22 15. Agricultural Awareness License Plates - such plates shall
23 be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax

1 Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
2 Forestry in consultation with the Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued
3 to any person wishing to demonstrate support of the Department's Ag
4 in the Classroom Education Program. As provided in this section, an
5 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
6 Section 1104.3 of this title;

7 16. Oklahoma Statehood Centennial License Plates - such plates
8 shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to commemorate
9 the centennial of Oklahoma's admission to statehood in 1907. The
10 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
11 Capitol Complex and Centennial Commemoration Commission. As
12 provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
13 deposited in the Oklahoma Capitol Complex and Centennial
14 Commemoration Commission Revolving Fund created in Section 98.5 of
15 Title 73 of the Oklahoma Statutes;

16 17. Support Education License Plates - such plates shall be
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
18 by the State Department of Education in consultation with the
19 Oklahoma Arts Council, and issued to any person wishing to
20 demonstrate support for education in this state. All motor license
21 agents shall display a sample of the Support Education License plate
22 in the area of the business accessed by the public. Twenty-three

1 Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee collected shall be apportioned as
2 follows:

- 3 a. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Education
4 Reform Revolving Fund,
- 5 b. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the Higher
6 Education Revolving Fund,
- 7 c. five percent (5%) shall be deposited to the State
8 Career Technology Fund, and
- 9 d. eighty-five percent (85%) of the fee shall be
10 deposited to the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund as
11 set forth in Section 17-108 of Title 70 of the
12 Oklahoma Statutes.

13 However, when the Teachers' Retirement Benefit Fund attains a
14 seventy percent (70%) funded ratio based on an annual actuarial
15 valuation as required by law, the amount of the fee shall be
16 apportioned equally pursuant to subparagraphs a, b and c of this
17 paragraph;

18 18. Retired Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers License Plates -
19 such plates shall be designed and issued to any retired officer of
20 the Oklahoma Highway Patrol. The license plate shall have the
21 legend "Oklahoma" and shall contain, in the center of the plate, the
22 Highway Patrol Officers patch using the same colors and pattern as
23 used in the patch. Centered on the bottom of the license plate

1 shall be the word "Retired". The letters "TRP" shall be used in
2 combination with three numbers on either side of the insignia or
3 emblem. The color of the letters and numbers shall be brown.
4 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of
5 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to
6 provide proof of eligibility annually. The surviving spouse of any
7 deceased retired officer of the Oklahoma Highway Patrol, if the
8 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is
9 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a Retired
10 Oklahoma Highway Patrol Officers license plate. As provided in this
11 section, an amount of the fee collected shall be deposited into the
12 Law Enforcement Retirement Fund;

13 19. Boy Scouts of America Supporter License Plates - such
14 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
15 demonstrate support for the Boy Scouts of America. The plates shall
16 be issued to any person in any combination of numbers and letters
17 from one to a maximum of seven, as for personalized license plates.
18 The plate shall contain the official Boy Scouts of America logo.
19 The Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into
20 a licensing agreement with the Boy Scouts of America for any
21 licensing fees which may be required in order to use the Boy Scouts
22 of America logo or design. The licensing agreement shall provide

1 for a payment to the Boy Scouts of America of not more than Twenty
2 Dollars (\$20.00) for each license plate issued;

3 20. Urban Forestry and Beautification License Plates - such
4 plates shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the
5 Tax Commission, by the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and
6 Forestry in consultation with nonprofit organizations in this state
7 that develop and operate programs to encourage urban forestry and
8 beautification, and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate
9 support of such programs. As provided in this section, an amount of
10 the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in Section 1104.5
11 of this title;

12 21. Oklahoma State Parks Supporter License Plates - such plates
13 shall be designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax
14 Commission by the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation Department, and
15 issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma
16 state parks system. Twenty-three Dollars (\$23.00) of the fee
17 collected shall be deposited in the Oklahoma Tourism and Recreation
18 Department Revolving Fund. Such money shall be designated for and
19 may only be expended for the support of Oklahoma state parks;

20 22. Adoption Creates Families License Plates - such plates
21 shall be issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support of
22 pregnant women who are committed to placing their children for
23 adoption and wishing to provide assistance to guardians, adoptive

1 parents and other created families to assist in the adoption and
2 placement of children in permanent, safe homes. The license plates
3 shall be designed and final terminology delivered in consultation
4 with the Oklahoma Adoption Coalition and the Department of Human
5 Services. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee collected shall
6 be deposited in a revolving fund established in the State Treasury
7 for and to be used by the Department of Human Services for the
8 implementation of the Investing in Stronger Oklahoma Families Act
9 specifically for created families;

10 23. Choose Life License Plates - such plates shall be designed,
11 subject to criteria presented to the Tax Commission, by Choose Life,
12 Inc., and issued to any person who wishes to demonstrate support of
13 organizations that encourage adoption as a positive choice for women
14 with unplanned pregnancies. As provided in this section, an amount
15 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Choose Life
16 Assistance Program Revolving Fund established in Section 1104.6 of
17 this title;

18 24. Future Farmers of America License Plate - such plates shall
19 be designed and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for
20 the Oklahoma FFA (formerly known as Future Farmers of America). The
21 license plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma
22 FFA Foundation Board of Directors. As provided in this section, an

1 amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
2 Section 1104.7 of this title;

3 25. Lions Club License Plates - such plates shall be designed
4 and issued to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the Lions
5 Club of Oklahoma. The plates shall be issued to any person in any
6 combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven,
7 as for personalized license plates. The license plates shall be
8 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation
9 and shall contain the official logo of the International Association
10 of Lions Clubs. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
11 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma Lions Service
12 Foundation. The licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to
13 the Oklahoma Lions Service Foundation of not more than Ten Dollars
14 (\$10.00) for each license plate issued;

15 26. Color Oklahoma License Plates - such plates shall be
16 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission
17 by the Oklahoma Native Plant Society, and issued to any person
18 wishing to demonstrate support for preserving and planting
19 wildflowers and native plants in Oklahoma and to promote Oklahoma's
20 wildflower heritage through education. As provided in this section,
21 an amount of the fee collected shall be apportioned as provided in
22 Section 1104.8 of this title;

1 27. Girl Scouts of the United States of America Supporter
2 License Plates - such plates shall be designed and issued to any
3 person wishing to demonstrate support for the Girl Scouts of the
4 United States of America. The plates shall be issued to any person
5 in any combination of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of
6 seven, as for personalized license plates. The plate shall contain
7 the official Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo. The
8 Tax Commission shall be authorized, if necessary, to enter into a
9 licensing agreement with the Girl Scouts of the United States of
10 America for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use
11 the Girl Scouts of the United States of America logo or design. The
12 licensing agreement shall provide for a payment to the Girl Scouts
13 of Magic Empire Council, acting on behalf of all Oklahoma Girl Scout
14 councils, of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
15 plate issued;

16 28. Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon License Plates - such
17 plates shall be designed and issued to any person wishing to
18 demonstrate support for the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon. The
19 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma City
20 Memorial Marathon. The Tax Commission shall be authorized to enter
21 into a licensing agreement with the Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon
22 for any licensing fees which may be required in order to use the
23 Oklahoma City Memorial Marathon logo or design. The licensing

1 agreement shall provide for a payment to the Oklahoma City Memorial
2 Marathon of not more than Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) for each license
3 plate issued;

4 29. Oklahoma Scenic Rivers License Plate - such plates shall be
5 designed to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers. The
6 plates shall be designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Scenic
7 Rivers Commission. Twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00) of the fee shall be
8 apportioned to the Oklahoma Scenic Rivers Commission;

9 30. Fight Cancer License Plate - such plates shall be designed
10 to demonstrate support for the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry.
11 The plate shall contain the American Cancer Society logo. The
12 American Cancer Society logo shall be used in accordance with the
13 American Cancer Society's branding guidelines and shall only be
14 utilized to support the Oklahoma Central Cancer Registry. Twenty
15 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee shall be apportioned to the Oklahoma
16 Central Cancer Registry Revolving Fund;

17 31. Animal Friendly License Plate - such plates shall be
18 designed and issued to any person wishing to demonstrate support for
19 controlling the overpopulation of dogs and cats through educational
20 and sterilization efforts. The plates shall be designed in
21 consultation with the Veterinary Medical Association. Twenty
22 Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee collected shall be designated by the
23 purchaser of the plate to be deposited in the Oklahoma Pet

1 Overpopulation Fund created in Section 2368.13 of Title 68 of the
2 Oklahoma Statutes or the Animal Friendly Revolving Fund created in
3 Section 1104.10 of this title;

4 32. Patriot License Plate - such plates shall be designed in
5 consultation with the Military Department of Oklahoma and issued to
6 any person wishing to demonstrate support for Oklahoma residents who
7 are members of the Oklahoma National Guard and deployed on active
8 duty. The plates shall be issued to any person in any combination
9 of numbers and letters from one to a maximum of seven, as for
10 personalized license plates. As provided in this section, a portion
11 of the fee collected shall be deposited in the Patriot License Plate
12 Revolving Fund created in Section 2 of this act; ~~and~~

13 33. Armed Forces Veterans Motorcycle License Plate - such
14 plates shall be designed for use on a motorcycle in consultation
15 with A Brotherhood Aiming Toward Education of Oklahoma, Inc.
16 (ABATE), and issued to any honorably discharged former member of the
17 United States Armed Forces wishing to demonstrate support for the
18 45th Infantry Division Museum. Persons applying for such license
19 plate must show proof of past military service. As provided in this
20 section, a portion of the fee collected shall be deposited in the
21 45th Infantry Division Museum Fund created in Section 235.1 of Title
22 44 of the Oklahoma Statutes; and

1 34. March of Dimes License Plate - such plates shall be issued
2 to persons wishing to demonstrate support for the March of Dimes
3 mission to improve the health of babies by preventing birth defects,
4 premature birth and infant mortality. The license plates shall be
5 designed in consultation with the Oklahoma Chapter March of Dimes.
6 As provided in this section, an amount of the fee collected shall be
7 deposited in the Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature Birth and
8 Infant Mortality Fund established in Section 2 of this act.

9 C. The fee for such plates shall be Thirty-five Dollars
10 (\$35.00) and shall be in addition to all other registration fees
11 provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act. The
12 fee shall be apportioned as follows:

13 1. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) or any other amount as provided in
14 this title of the fee shall be apportioned as provided or deposited
15 in a fund as specified within the paragraph authorizing the special
16 license plate;

17 2. Eight Dollars (\$8.00) of the fee shall be deposited in the
18 Oklahoma Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the
19 administration of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act;
20 and

21 3. Any remaining amounts of the fee shall be apportioned as
22 provided in Section 1104 of this title.

1 SECTION 2. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
2 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1104.12 of Title 47, unless
3 there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

4 A. Twenty Dollars (\$20.00) of the fee authorized by Section
5 1135.5 of Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes for the Oklahoma March
6 of Dimes license plate shall be deposited to the Oklahoma Prevent
7 Birth Defects, Premature Birth and Infant Mortality Fund established
8 in subsection B of this section.

9 B. There is hereby created in the State Treasury a revolving
10 fund to be designated the "Oklahoma Prevent Birth Defects, Premature
11 Birth and Infant Mortality Fund" and administered by the State
12 Department of Health. The fund shall be a continuing fund, not
13 subject to fiscal year limitations, and shall consist of all the
14 monies received by the State Department of Health pursuant to the
15 provisions of Section 1135.5 of this title. All monies accruing to
16 the credit of the fund are appropriated and may be budgeted and
17 expended by the Department of Health at the beginning of each fiscal
18 year for the purpose of providing grants to the Oklahoma Chapter of
19 March of Dimes for purposes of preventing birth defects, premature
20 birth and infant mortality. Expenditures from the fund shall be
21 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
22 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for
23 approval and payment.
