9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 59 O.S. 2001, Section 475.1, as  
11 amended by Section 1, Chapter 115, O.S.L. 2005 (59 O.S. Supp. 2005,  
12 Section 475.1), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 475.1 In order to safeguard life, health and property,  
14 and to promote the public welfare, the practice of engineering and  
15 the practice of land surveying in this state are hereby declared to  
16 be subject to regulation in the public interest. It shall be  
17 unlawful to practice or to offer to practice engineering or land  
18 surveying in this state, as defined in the provisions of Section  
19 475.1 et seq. of this title, or to use in connection with any name  
20 or otherwise assume or advertise any title or description tending to  
21 convey the impression that any person is an engineer, professional  
22 engineer, land surveyor or professional land surveyor, unless such  
23 person has been duly licensed under the provisions of Section 475.1  
24 et seq. of this title, provided that any company that is solely a

1 manufacturing company that does not engage in the practice of  
2 engineering as defined in Section 475.2 of this title, is exempt  
3 from the provisions of this section. The practice of engineering or  
4 land surveying shall be deemed a privilege granted by the state  
5 through the State Board of Licensure for Professional Engineers and  
6 Land Surveyors, based on the qualifications of the individual as  
7 evidenced by a certificate of licensure, which shall not be  
8 transferable.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2006.
