5 SENATE BILL NO. 1934 - By: CORN of the Senate and BLACKWELL of the

7 [corrections - centralized food buying - agricultural and

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 57 O.S. 2001, Section 533, is
12 amended to read as follows:

13 Section 533. The Director of the Department of Corrections ~~will~~
14 shall develop and promulgate a policy that will centralize, at the
15 Department of Corrections, the procurement of all items of food
16 supplies, other than fresh food local buys, for all institutions
17 within the Department of Corrections. The Department shall manage
18 all agricultural and livestock services so the maximum quantity and
19 quality of fruit, vegetables, herbs, grasses, seeds, meat, poultry,
20 eggs and dairy products are produced for institutional consumption
21 with inmate or volunteer labor, which may include, but shall not be
22 limited to, any type of work release labor, community or
23 intermediate sanctions labor, jail labor or otherwise. Any excess
24 food or product produced shall be sold at competitive prices to the
25 public or private markets or sold or traded with other states or

1 political subdivisions or state and local agencies for goods and
2 services beneficial to the Department, this state, its political
3 subdivisions, jails or any state or local agency of this state. The
4 agricultural services division of the Oklahoma State University
5 shall provide services to the Department for improved land
6 utilization and product and livestock enhancements at least
7 annually. The Department shall develop a detailed plan to implement
8 the provisions of this section and shall submit the plan to the
9 legislature by January 15 of each year.

10 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
11 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
12 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
13 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
