Senate Bill No. 34

SENATE BILL NO. 34 - By: WILSON and RILEY of the Senate and BROWN of the House.

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; naming certain highway the "Senator Herb Rozell Highway"; requiring Department of Transportation to create certain permanent markers; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

State Highway 62 from State Highway 82 to the Muskogee County Line shall be designated as the "Senator Herb Rozell Highway". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed on the highway bearing his name.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
