10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
12 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 7607 of Title 10, unless there
13 is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

14 State beneficiary public trusts created pursuant to the
15 provisions of the Lead-Impacted Communities Relocation Assistance
16 Act, shall consist of, but not be limited to, members appointed by
17 the Governor who shall represent municipal and county governments
18 and the school districts within the boundaries of federal Superfund
19 sites. Such trusts may be made up of any number of members the
20 Governor deems necessary to implement the provisions of the Lead-
21 Impacted Communities Relocation Assistance Act.

22 SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
23 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
24 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
25 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
