4 SENATE BILL NO. 466 - By: CRAIN of the Senate and SULLIVAN of the
5 House.

6 An Act relating to counties and county officers; amending 19
7 O.S. 2001, Section 1301, which relates to vacation and sick
8 leave plan; authorizing the board of county commissioners to
9 provide payments to certain employees for certain leave;
10 providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 19 O.S. 2001, Section 1301, is
13 amended to read as follows:

14 Section 1301. Each county may develop and maintain a formal
15 plan for vacation and sick leave for all regular employees. No
16 person chosen by election or appointment to fill an elective office
17 shall be subject to any leave plan, nor shall such person be
18 eligible for accrual of any leave benefits.

19 Any leave plan adopted by a county shall not extend benefits to
20 any employee in excess of leave benefits available to a regular
21 state employee in the classified service. Provided, however, that
22 the board of county commissioners of any county may provide for
23 payments to regular employees for accrued leave of whatever kind,
24 upon such terms as the board in its discretion may provide,
25 notwithstanding any provision to the contrary concerning state
26 employees.

1 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

2 SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation
3 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby
4 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and
5 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
