6 SENATE BILL NO. 507 - By: BASS of the Senate and CAREY and ROUSSELOT  
7 of the House.

8 **[ motor vehicles - modifying qualifications - exempting fee**  
9 **and requirements - providing for additional special license**  
10 **plate - effective date ]**

11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

12 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 11, Chapter 504, O.S.L.  
13 2004 (47 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 1135.2), is amended to read as  
14 follows:

15 Section 1135.2 A. The Oklahoma Tax Commission is hereby  
16 authorized to design and issue appropriate official special license  
17 plates to persons in recognition of their service or awards as  
18 provided by this section.

19 Special license plates shall not be transferred to any other  
20 person but shall be removed from the vehicle upon transfer of  
21 ownership and retained. The special license plate may then be used  
22 on another vehicle but only after such other vehicle has been  
23 registered for the current year.

1 Special license plates shall be renewed each year by the Tax  
2 Commission or a motor license agent. The Tax Commission shall  
3 annually notify by mail all persons issued special license plates.  
4 The notice shall contain all necessary information and shall contain  
5 instructions for the renewal procedure upon presentation to a motor  
6 license agent or the Tax Commission. The license plates shall be  
7 issued on a staggered system except for legislative plates and  
8 amateur radio operator license plates.

9 The Tax Commission is hereby directed to develop and implement a  
10 system whereby motor license agents are permitted to accept  
11 applications for special license plates authorized under this  
12 section. The motor license agent shall confirm the applicant's  
13 eligibility, if applicable, collect and deposit any amount  
14 specifically authorized by law, accept and process the necessary  
15 information directly into such system and generate a receipt  
16 accordingly. For performance of these duties, motor license agents  
17 shall retain the fee provided in Section 1141.1 of ~~Title 47 of the~~  
18 ~~Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title for registration of a motor vehicle.  
19 The motor license agent fees for acceptance of applications and  
20 renewals shall be paid out of the Oklahoma Tax Commission  
21 Reimbursement Fund.

22 B. The special license plates provided by this section are as  
23 follows:

1           1. Prisoner of War License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
3 States Armed Forces and civilians who were former prisoners of war  
4 held by a foreign country and who can provide proper certification  
5 of that status. Such persons may apply for a prisoner of war  
6 license plate for no more than two vehicles with each vehicle having  
7 a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving  
8 spouse of any deceased former prisoner of war, if the spouse has not  
9 since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
10 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a prisoner of war  
11 license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one  
12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
13 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
14 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
15 fees levied by Section 1132 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~  
16 this title;

17           2. National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma National  
19 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
20 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
21 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

22           3. Air National Guard License Plates - such plates shall be  
23 designed for active or retired members of the Oklahoma Air National

1 Guard. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide  
2 proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be  
3 required to provide proof of eligibility annually;

4 4. United States Armed Forces - such plates shall be designed  
5 for active, retired, former or reserve members of the United States  
6 Armed Forces, and shall identify which branch of service, and carry  
7 the emblem and name of either the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
8 Coast Guard, according to the branch of service to which the member  
9 belongs or did belong. Former members who have been dishonorably  
10 discharged shall not be eligible for such plates. Persons applying  
11 for such license plate must show proof of present or past military  
12 service by presenting a valid Uniformed Services Identity Card or  
13 the United States Department of Defense Form (DD)214. Retired or  
14 former members who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof  
15 of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required  
16 to provide proof of eligibility annually;

17 5. Congressional Medal of Honor Recipient License Plates - such  
18 plates shall be designed for any resident of this state who has been  
19 awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor. Such persons may apply  
20 for a Congressional Medal of Honor recipient license plate for each  
21 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
22 There shall be no registration fee for the issuance of this plate;

1           6. Missing In Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who are  
3 missing in action. The spouse of such missing person, if the spouse  
4 has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is  
5 terminated by death, divorce, or annulment, and each parent of the  
6 missing person may apply for a missing in action license plate upon  
7 presenting proper certification that the person is missing in action  
8 and that the person making the application is the qualifying spouse  
9 or the parent of the missing person. The qualifying spouse and each  
10 parent of the missing person may each apply for the missing in  
11 action license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
12 of one (1) ton or less;

13           7. Purple Heart Recipient License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed for any resident of this state presenting proper  
15 certification from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs  
16 or the Armed Forces of the United States certifying that such  
17 resident is a veteran who has been awarded the Purple Heart military  
18 decoration ~~and, upon the death of the recipient, the spouse of the~~  
19 ~~recipient.~~ Such persons may apply for a Purple Heart recipient  
20 license plate for vehicles having a rated carrying capacity of one  
21 (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any deceased veteran who  
22 has been awarded the Purple Heart military decoration, if such  
23 spouse has not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage has

1 been terminated by death, divorce or annulment, may apply for such  
2 plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton  
3 or less. No other license plate or fees shall be required for such  
4 plates;

5 8. Pearl Harbor Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
7 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
8 the United States as being:

9 a. a member of the United States Armed Forces on December  
10 7, 1941,

11 b. stationed on December 7, 1941, during the hours of  
12 7:55 a.m. to 9:45 a.m. Hawaii time at Pearl Harbor,  
13 the island of Oahu, or offshore at a distance not to  
14 exceed three (3) miles, and

15 c. a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
16 States Armed Forces.

17 Such person may apply for a Pearl Harbor Survivor license plate  
18 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
19 less;

20 9. Iwo Jima License Plates - such plates shall be designed for  
21 any resident of this state who can be verified by the United States  
22 Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United  
23 States as being:

- 1           a.    a member of the United States Armed Forces in February  
2                   of 1945,  
3           b.    stationed in February of 1945 on or in the immediate  
4                   vicinity of the island of Iwo Jima, and  
5           c.    a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
6                   States Armed Forces.

7           Such person may apply for an Iwo Jima license plate for each  
8 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

9           Such license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK" and shall  
10 contain three letters and three numbers. Between the letters and  
11 numbers shall be a logo of the flag-raising at Iwo Jima. Below the  
12 letters, logo and numbers, the plate shall contain the words "FEB."  
13 at the left, "Iwo Jima" in the center and "1945" at the right. Such  
14 plates shall not be subject to the design requirements of any other  
15 license plates prescribed by law other than the space for the  
16 placement of the yearly decals for each succeeding year of  
17 registration after the initial issue;

18           10. D-Day Survivor License Plates - such plates shall be  
19 designed for any resident of this state who can be verified by the  
20 United States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
21 the United States as being:

- 22           a.    a member of the United States Armed Forces on June 6,  
23                   1944,

- 1           b.    a participant in the Allied invasion of the coast of  
2                    Normandy on June 6, 1944; provided, if such  
3                    participation cannot be verified by the United States  
4                    Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of  
5                    the United States, the Tax Commission may, in its  
6                    discretion, accept evidence of such participation from  
7                    the person applying for the license plate, and
- 8           c.    a recipient of an honorable discharge from the United  
9                    States Armed Forces.

10           Such person may apply for a D-Day Survivor license plate for  
11 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

12           11. Killed in Action License Plates - such plates shall be  
13 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
14 killed in action. The spouse of the deceased person, if the spouse  
15 has not remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by  
16 death, divorce, or annulment, may apply for a killed in action  
17 license plate upon presenting proper certification that the person  
18 was killed in action and that the person making the application is  
19 the qualifying spouse of the deceased person. The qualifying spouse  
20 may apply for a killed in action license plate for no more than two  
21 vehicles with each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1)  
22 ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
23 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to

1 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
2 fees levied by Section 1132 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~  
3 this title;

4 12. Gold Star Parents License Plates - such plates shall be  
5 designed to honor members of the United States Armed Forces who were  
6 killed during a war. The parents of the deceased person may apply  
7 for a gold star license plate upon presenting proper certification  
8 that the person was killed during a war and that the person making  
9 the application is the parent of the deceased person. The parent  
10 may apply for a gold star parent license plate for no more than two  
11 vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying capacity of one  
12 (1) ton or less. The fee provided by this section for the special  
13 license plate authorized by this paragraph shall be in addition to  
14 all other registration fees provided by law, except the registration  
15 fees levied by Section 1132 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~  
16 this title;

17 13. Military Decoration License Plates - such plates shall be  
18 designed for any resident of this state who has been awarded the  
19 Distinguished Service Medal, the Distinguished Service Cross, the  
20 Distinguished Flying Cross, the Bronze Star military decoration or  
21 the Silver Star military decoration. Such persons may apply for a  
22 military decoration license plate for each vehicle with a rated  
23 carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1           14. Vietnam Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
2 designed for honorably discharged or present members of the United  
3 States Armed Forces who served in the Vietnam Conflict. Such  
4 persons may apply for a Vietnam veteran license plate for each  
5 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

6           15. Police Officer License Plates - such plates shall be  
7 designed for any currently employed or retired municipal police  
8 officer. Police officers may apply for police officer license  
9 plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or less  
10 upon proof of employment by or retirement from a municipal police  
11 department by either an identification card or letter from the chief  
12 of the police department or the Oklahoma Police Pension and  
13 Retirement Board. Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall  
14 provide proof of eligibility upon initial application, but shall not  
15 be required to provide proof of eligibility annually. The license  
16 plates shall be designed in consultation with municipal police  
17 departments of this state;

18           16. World War II Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
19 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
20 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
21 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
22 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
23 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from

1 September 16, 1940, to December 7, 1945. The former members may  
2 apply for a World War II Veteran license plate for vehicles with a  
3 rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

4 The license plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma" and shall  
5 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
6 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
7 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
8 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member  
9 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the  
10 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two  
11 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the  
12 bottom of the license plate shall be the words "WORLD WAR II";

13 17. Korean War Veteran License Plates - such plates shall be  
14 designed to honor honorably discharged former members of the United  
15 States Armed Forces who are residents of this state and who can be  
16 verified by the Oklahoma Military Department, the Department of  
17 Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the United States as having  
18 served on federal active duty anytime during the period from  
19 ~~September 1, 1950, to April 27, 1954~~ June 27, 1950, to January 31,  
20 1955, both dates inclusive. The former members may apply for a  
21 Korean War Veteran license plate for vehicles with a rated carrying  
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less.

1       The license plate shall have the legend "OKLAHOMA" and shall  
2 contain, in the center of the plate, either the Thunderbird Insignia  
3 of the 45th Infantry Division in the prescribed red and gold  
4 coloring or the emblem of the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines or  
5 Coast Guard according to the branch of service to which the member  
6 belonged. For the purpose of license plate identification, the  
7 plate shall contain four digits, two digits at the left and two  
8 digits at the right of the insignia or emblem. Centered on the  
9 bottom of the license plate shall be the word "KOREA";

10       18. Municipal Official License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed for persons elected to a municipal office in this state and  
12 shall designate the name of the municipality and the district or  
13 ward in which the municipal official serves. The plates shall only  
14 be produced upon application;

15       19. Red Cross Volunteer License Plates - such plates shall be  
16 designed to honor American Red Cross volunteers and staff who are  
17 residents of this state. Such persons must present an  
18 identification card issued by the American Red Cross and bearing a  
19 photograph of the person. The license plate shall be designed with  
20 the assistance of the American Red Cross and shall have the legend  
21 "Oklahoma OK!" in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the legend the  
22 symbol of the American Red Cross and no more than three letters and  
23 three numbers shall be in the color Pantone 186C Red. Below the

1 symbol and letters and numbers shall be the words "American Red  
2 Cross" in black. The plates shall not be subject to the design  
3 requirements of any other license plates prescribed by law other  
4 than the space for the placement of the yearly decals for each  
5 succeeding year of registration after the initial issue;

6 20. Veterans of Foreign Wars License Plates - such plates shall  
7 be designed to honor the veterans of foreign wars and issued to any  
8 resident of this state who is a member of a Veterans of Foreign Wars  
9 organization in this state. Such persons may apply for Veterans of  
10 Foreign Wars license plates upon proof of membership in a Veterans  
11 of Foreign Wars organization. The license plate shall be designed  
12 in consultation with the Veterans of Foreign Wars organization;

13 21. Desert Storm License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
14 and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of the  
15 United States Armed Forces who served in the Persian Gulf Crisis and  
16 the Desert Storm operation. Such persons may apply for a Desert  
17 Storm license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
18 of one (1) ton or less;

19 22. Military Reserve Unit License Plates - such plates shall be  
20 designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member of  
21 a reserve unit of the United States Armed Forces. Such persons may  
22 apply for a Military Reserve Unit license plate for each vehicle  
23 with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1           23. Oklahoma City Bombing Victims and Survivors License Plates  
2 - such plates shall be designed and issued to any victim or survivor  
3 of the bombing attack on the Alfred P. Murrah Federal Building in  
4 downtown Oklahoma City on April 19, 1995;

5           24. Civil Air Patrol License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed and issued to any person who is a member of the Civil Air  
7 Patrol. Such persons may apply for a Civil Air Patrol license plate  
8 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
9 less upon proof of membership in the Civil Air Patrol. The license  
10 plate shall be designed in consultation with the Civil Air Patrol;

11          25. Ninety-Nines License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
12 and issued to members of the Ninety-Nines. Persons applying for  
13 such license plate must show proof of membership in the Ninety-  
14 Nines. The license plates shall be designed in consultation with  
15 the Ninety-Nines;

16          26. Combat Infantryman Badge License Plates - such plates shall  
17 be designed to honor recipients of the Combat Infantryman Badge.  
18 The plate shall have the legend "Oklahoma OK". Below the legend  
19 shall be the Combat Infantryman Badge and three numbers. Below the  
20 badge and the numbers shall be the words "Combat Infantryman Badge".  
21 Such persons may apply for a Combat Infantryman Badge license plate  
22 for each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or  
23 less;

1           27. Somalia Combat Veterans License Plates - such plates shall  
2 be designed and issued to any honorably discharged or present member  
3 of the United States Armed Forces who saw combat in the United  
4 Nations relief effort. Such persons may apply for a Somalia Combat  
5 Veteran license plate for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
6 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

7           28. Police Chaplain License Plates - such plates shall be  
8 designed and issued to members of the International Conference of  
9 Police Chaplains (ICPC) who have completed the ICPC requirements for  
10 basic certification as a police chaplain. The license plates shall  
11 be designed in consultation with the ICPC;

12           29. Joint Service Commendation Medal License Plates - such  
13 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
14 who has been awarded the Joint Service Commendation Medal by the  
15 United States Secretary of Defense;

16           30. Merchant Marine License Plates - such plates shall be  
17 designed, subject to criteria to be presented to the Tax Commission  
18 by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs, and issued to any  
19 person who during combat was a member of the Merchant Marines as  
20 certified by the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs. Such  
21 license plate may be issued for each vehicle with a rated carrying  
22 capacity of one (1) ton or less;

1           31. Legislative License Plates - such plates shall be designed  
2 for persons elected to the Oklahoma Legislature and shall designate  
3 the house of the Legislature in which the legislator serves and the  
4 district number;

5           32. Disabled Veterans License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed for persons presenting proper certification from the United  
7 States Department of Veterans Affairs or the Armed Forces of the  
8 United States certifying such veteran has a service-connected  
9 disability rating of fifty percent (50%) or more, regardless which  
10 agency pays the disability benefits, or that such veteran has been  
11 awarded a vehicle by the United States government or receives a  
12 grant from the United States Department of Veterans Affairs for the  
13 purchase of an automobile due to a service-connected disability  
14 rating or due to the loss of use of a limb or an eye. Such persons  
15 may apply to the Tax Commission for a disabled veterans license  
16 plate or to a motor license agent for a regular license plate for no  
17 more than two vehicles with each vehicle having a rated carrying  
18 capacity of one (1) ton or less. The surviving spouse of any  
19 deceased disabled veteran, if the spouse has not since remarried, or  
20 if remarried, the remarriage is terminated by death, divorce, or  
21 annulment, may apply for a disabled veterans license plate for one  
22 vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.

1        If the person qualifies for a disabled veterans license plate  
2 and is also eligible for an insignia as a physically disabled person  
3 under the provisions of Section 15-112 of ~~Title 47 of the Oklahoma~~  
4 ~~Statutes~~ this title, the person shall be eligible to receive a  
5 disabled veterans license plate that also displays the international  
6 accessibility symbol, which is a stylized human figure in a  
7 wheelchair. Upon the death of the disabled veteran with a disabled  
8 veterans license plate with the international accessibility symbol,  
9 the plate shall be returned to the Tax Commission;

10        33. United States Air Force Association License Plates - such  
11 plates shall be designed for members of the United States Air Force  
12 Association. Persons applying for such license plate must show  
13 proof of membership in the Association. The license plates shall be  
14 designed in consultation with the Association;

15        34. Oklahoma Military Academy Alumni License Plates - such  
16 plates shall be designed and issued to any resident of this state  
17 who is an alumnus of the Oklahoma Military Academy. Such persons  
18 may apply for an Oklahoma Military Academy Alumnus license plate for  
19 each vehicle with a rated carrying capacity of one (1) ton or less.  
20 The license plates shall be designed in consultation with the  
21 Oklahoma Military Academy and shall contain the shield of the  
22 Academy;

1           35. Amateur Radio Operator License Plates - such plates shall  
2 be designed and issued to any person, holding a valid operator's  
3 license, technician class or better, issued by the Federal  
4 Communications Commission, and who is also the owner of a motor  
5 vehicle currently registered in Oklahoma, in which has been  
6 installed amateur mobile transmitting and receiving equipment.  
7 Eligible persons shall be entitled to two special vehicle  
8 identification plates as herein provided. Application for such  
9 identification plates shall be on a form prescribed by the Oklahoma  
10 Tax Commission and the plates issued to such applicant shall have  
11 stamped thereon the word "Oklahoma" and bear the official call  
12 letters of the radio station assigned by the Federal Communications  
13 Commission to the individual amateur operator thereof. All  
14 applications for such plates must be made to the Oklahoma Tax  
15 Commission on or before the first day of October of any year for  
16 such plates for the following calendar year and must be accompanied  
17 by the fee required in this section together with a certificate, or  
18 such other evidence as the Commission may require, of proof that  
19 applicant has a valid technician class or better amateur operator's  
20 license and proof of his ownership of a vehicle in which radio  
21 receiving and transmitting equipment is installed. Applicants shall  
22 only be entitled to one set of special identification plates in any  
23 one (1) year, and such calendar year shall be stamped thereon. The

1 right to such special identification plates herein provided for  
2 shall continue until the amateur radio operator's license of the  
3 person to whom such plates are issued expires or is revoked;

4 ~~36. Former Legislator License Plates - such plates shall be~~  
5 ~~designed and issued to persons who have previously been elected to~~  
6 ~~the Oklahoma Legislature and are no longer serving in the Oklahoma~~  
7 ~~Legislature. The plates shall indicate the house of the Legislature~~  
8 ~~the person last served in and the district number and shall indicate~~  
9 ~~that the person is a former member of the Oklahoma Legislature;~~

10 ~~37.~~ American Legion License Plates - such plates shall be  
11 designed for members of the American Legion. Persons applying for  
12 such license plate must show proof of membership. The license  
13 plates shall be designed in consultation with the American Legion of  
14 Oklahoma; ~~and~~

15 ~~38.~~ 37. Deputy Sheriff License Plate Plates - such plates shall  
16 be designed for any currently employed or retired county sheriff or  
17 deputy sheriff. County sheriffs or deputy sheriffs may apply for  
18 such plates for vehicles with a rated capacity of one (1) ton or  
19 less upon proof of employment by or retirement from a county  
20 sheriff's office by either an identification card or letter from the  
21 county sheriff or a government-sponsored retirement board from which  
22 the county sheriff or deputy sheriff may be receiving a pension.  
23 Retirees who are eligible for such plates shall provide proof of

1 eligibility upon initial application, but shall not be required to  
2 provide proof of eligibility annually. The license plates shall be  
3 designed in consultation with the county sheriff offices of this  
4 state; and

5 38. Surviving Spouse License Plates - such plates shall be  
6 designed for any resident of this state who is the surviving spouse  
7 of an honorably discharged veteran who died due to or as a  
8 consequence of a service-connected disability. Such surviving  
9 spouse may, if not since remarried, or if remarried, the remarriage  
10 is terminated by death, divorce or annulment, apply for a Surviving  
11 Spouse license plate for one vehicle with a rated carrying capacity  
12 of one (1) ton or less.

13 C. Unless otherwise provided by this section, the fee for such  
14 plates shall be Eight Dollars (\$8.00) and shall be in addition to  
15 all other registration fees provided by the Oklahoma Vehicle License  
16 and Registration Act. Such fees shall be deposited in the Oklahoma  
17 Tax Commission Reimbursement Fund to be used for the administration  
18 of the Oklahoma Vehicle License and Registration Act.

19 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
