5 SENATE BILL NO. 518 - By: WILCOXSON of the Senate and BALKMAN of the
6 House.

7 [intoxicating liquors - pertaining to the sale or serving
8 of low-point beer - penalties - effective date]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified
11 in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 220 of Title 37, unless there is
12 created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

13 A. No owner, operator, partner, manager, agent, employee, or
14 person having supervisory control of any establishment licensed to
15 sell low-point beer for consumption on the premises and subject to
16 the provisions of subsection B of Section 246 of Title 37 of the
17 Oklahoma Statutes shall:

18 1. Sell or offer to sell to any person or group of persons any
19 low-point beer at a price less than the price regularly charged for
20 low-point beer during the same calendar week, except at private
21 functions not open to the public;

22 2. Sell or offer to sell to any person an unlimited number of
23 drinks of low-point beer during any set period of time for a fixed
24 price, except at private functions not open to the public; or

1 3. Sell or offer to sell low-point beer to any person or group
2 of persons on any one day at prices less than those charged the
3 general public on that day, except at private functions not open to
4 the public.

5 B. Any person convicted of violating the provisions of this
6 section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of not
7 more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for each offense. Each act
8 in violation of this section shall be deemed a separate offense.

9 SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
