7 [state government - State Use Committee - modifying
8 purposes - effective date]

9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

10 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 74 O.S. 2001, Section 3004.2, as
11 last amended by Section 4, Chapter 404, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp.
12 2004, Section 3004.2), is amended to read as follows:

13 Section 3004.2 There is hereby created in the State Treasury a
14 revolving fund for the Department of Central Services to be
15 designated the "State Use Committee Revolving Fund". The fund shall
16 be a continuing fund, not subject to fiscal year limitations, and
17 shall consist of all proceeds from the one-percent fee on contracts
18 for purchases of products or services of the severely disabled, as
19 provided in Section 3004.1 of this title. The fund shall be
20 invested in any of the types of instruments in which the State
21 Treasurer is authorized by law to invest. Interest earned shall be
22 retained by the fund. All monies accruing to the credit of the fund
23 are hereby appropriated and may be budgeted and expended by the
24 Department of Central Services for the salary and other

1 administrative expenses of the buyer and clerical and technical
2 support in the Purchasing Division of the Department of Central
3 Services responsible for contracts for the products and services of
4 the severely disabled and expenses the Department incurs to support
5 Committee operations and for promoting goods and services provided
6 by qualified organizations. Expenditures from the fund shall be
7 made upon warrants issued by the State Treasurer against claims
8 filed as prescribed by law with the Director of State Finance for
9 approval and payment.

10 **SECTION 2.** This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
