5 SENATE BILL NO. 819 - By: SHURDEN of the Senate and ELLIS of the

7 [ crimes and punishments - storing firearms in locked  
8 vehicles -  
9 emergency ]

10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

11 SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 39, O.S.L. 2004  
12 (21 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 1289.7a), is amended to read as  
13 follows:

14 Section 1289.7a No person, property owner, tenant, employer, or  
15 business entity shall be permitted to establish any policy or rule  
16 that has the effect of prohibiting any legally authorized person,  
17 **except a convicted felon, in lawful possession of a firearm** from  
18 transporting and storing ~~firearms~~ such firearm in a locked vehicle  
19 on any property set aside for any vehicle; provided, such firearm is  
20 possessed, carried, transported and stored according to law.

21 SECTION 2. AMENDATORY 21 O.S. 2001, Section 1290.22, as  
22 amended by Section 2, Chapter 39, O.S.L. 2004 (21 O.S. Supp. 2004,  
23 Section 1290.22), is amended to read as follows:

24 Section 1290.22.

25 BUSINESS OWNER'S RIGHTS

1           A. Except as provided in subsection B of this section, nothing  
2 contained in any provision of the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act, ~~Section~~  
3 ~~1290.1 et seq. of this title,~~ shall be construed to limit, restrict  
4 or prohibit in any manner the existing rights of any person,  
5 property owner, tenant, employer, or business entity to control the  
6 possession of weapons on any property owned or controlled by the  
7 person or business entity.

8           B. No person, property owner, tenant, employer, or business  
9 entity shall be permitted to establish any policy or rule that has  
10 the effect of prohibiting any person, **except a convicted felon,**  
11 authorized to carry a firearm pursuant to a valid concealed handgun  
12 license from transporting and storing ~~firearms~~ such firearm in a  
13 locked vehicle on any property set aside for any vehicle; provided,  
14 such firearm is possessed, carried and transported according to the  
15 provisions of law relating to the Oklahoma Self-Defense Act.

16           SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation  
17 of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby  
18 declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and  
19 be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
