

An Act relating to criminal procedure; amending 22 O.S. 2001, Section 991b, as amended by Section 19, Chapter 460, O.S.L. 2002 (22 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 991b), which relates to revocation for suspended sentences; authorizing the Department of Corrections to respond with intermediate sanctions for technical violations of probation; stating time period to respond to technical violations; providing intermediate sanctions; requiring certain forms; requiring the Department of Corrections to develop sanction matrix, forms, policies and procedures; providing for certain hearing; establishing procedures for certain hearing; requiring preponderance of evidence for certain determination; stating authority of hearing officers; allowing offender to accept sanctions; providing consequences for failure to comply; providing for revocation proceedings or appeal when sanction is not voluntarily accepted by offender; allowing appeal from administrative hearing; and providing an effective date.
