

An Act relating to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; abolishing the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; providing for interpretation of certain statutory references; transferring the duties of enforcement and administration of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; transferring certain personnel, funds, records, encumbrances, equipment, and other items to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; providing requirements pertaining to transfer of employees; providing for transition coordinators and a transition team; providing duties of the transition team; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Sections 2-101, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 301, O.S.L. 2004, 2-103, as amended by Section 13, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2003, 2-103.1, 2-105, 2-106, 2-106.1, 2-107, 2-109, 2-110, 2-201, 2-301, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 338, O.S.L. 2003, 2-302 and 2-303, as last amended by Sections 59 and 61, Chapter 5, O.S.L. 2004, 2-309B and 2-309C, as amended by Sections 2 and 3, Chapter 300, O.S.L. 2004, 2-322, 2-323, 2-324, 2-326, 2-330 and 2-331, Section 1, Chapter 288, O.S.L. 2002, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 59, O.S.L. 2004, Section 2, Chapter 288, O.S.L. 2002, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 133, O.S.L. 2003, 2-503, as amended by Section 2, Chapter 537, O.S.L. 2004, 2-505, 2-506, as last amended by Section 3, Chapter 537, O.S.L. 2004, 2-508, as last amended by Section 16, Chapter 168, O.S.L. 2004 and 2-509 (63 O.S. Supp. 2004, Sections 2-101, 2-103, 2-301, 2-302, 2-303, 2-309B, 2-309C, 2-332, 2-333, 2-503, 2-506 and 2-508), which relate to the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act; modifying the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act to reflect the transfer of administration and enforcement from the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; providing for continuation of promulgated rules, regulations and forms; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 18c, as amended by Section 4, Chapter 438, O.S.L. 2002 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 18c), which relates to employment of attorneys by state agencies; authorizing the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation to employ attorneys for enforcement of the provisions of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances Act; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Sections 150.2, as last amended by Section 15, Chapter 461, O.S.L. 2003, 150.4, 150.5, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 77, O.S.L. 2002, 150.6, as amended by Section 14, Chapter 199, O.S.L. 2003, 150.7, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 42, O.S.L. 2002, 150.13, 150.21, as amended by Section 3, Chapter 42, O.S.L. 2002, 150.21a and 150.23, as amended by Section 15, Chapter 275, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Sections 150.2, 150.5, 150.6, 150.7, 150.21 and 150.23), which relate to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; modifying powers and duties of the Director of the Bureau; eliminating references to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Commission; changing procedure for appointment of the Director; placing Director under the supervision of the Secretary of Safety and Security; eliminating certain quarterly report; eliminating references to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; amending 74 O.S. 2001, Section 840-5.5, as last amended by Section 1, Chapter 462, O.S.L. 2004 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 840-5.5), which relates to the unclassified service; eliminating references to personnel for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control; placing the positions in the unclassified service for the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation; repealing 63 O.S. 2001, Sections 2-102 and 2-104.1, as last amended by Section 4, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2003 (63 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 2-104.1), which relate to the director of the Oklahoma

State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control and the Oklahoma State Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control Commission; repealing 74 O.S. 2001, Section 150.3, as last amended by Section 7, Chapter 229, O.S.L. 2003 (74 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 150.3), which relates to the Oklahoma State Bureau of Investigation Commission; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; providing effective dates; and declaring an emergency.
