

An Act relating to professions and occupations; amending 59 O.S. 2001, Sections 46.14, 148, 199.11, as amended by Section 6, Chapter 56, O.S.L. 2003, 328.32, 396.12c, as amended by Section 14, Chapter 57, O.S.L. 2003, 475.18, 509, as amended by Section 9, Chapter 523, O.S.L. 2004, 532, 567.8, as amended by Section 5, Chapter 190, O.S.L. 2003, 858-312, 858-723, 887.13, 888.9, 1310, 1370, as amended by Section 24, Chapter 313, O.S.L. 2004, 1503A, 1619, 1912, 1925.15 and 1941 (59 O.S. Supp. 2004, Sections 199.11, 396.12c, 567.8 and 1370), which relate to architects and landscape architects, podiatric physicians, cosmetologists, dentists, funeral directors, professional engineers and land surveyors, allopathic physicians, athletic trainers and apprentices, nurses, realtors, real estate appraisers, physical therapists, occupational therapists, bail bondsmen, psychologists, pawnbrokers, speech-language pathologists and audiologists, professional counselors, marital and family therapists, and licensed behavioral practitioners; modifying the prohibition to issue and renew licenses based on criminal conviction; providing certain appeal procedure; adding definition; and providing an effective date.
