

An Act relating to schools; creating the Task Force on School District Administrative Efficiency; stating purpose of the Task Force; requiring recommendations by a certain date; providing for membership, meetings, staffing, and travel reimbursement; creating the Student Tracking and Reporting (STAR) Pilot Program; stating purpose of the Pilot Program; stating objectives of the Pilot Program; requiring interoperability with certain student data management and reporting systems; directing exploration of delivery systems for certain purposes; requiring utilization of certain system model; requiring model to include certain capabilities; creating the Student Tracking and Reporting (STAR) Coordinating Committee; providing for membership, meetings, and travel reimbursement; directing the Committee to select school districts to participate in the Pilot Program; establishing qualifications of participating school districts; directing the Committee to develop certain standards and procedures; requiring the State Board of Education to contract with independent consultants at the direction of the Committee; requiring Committee to issue a report; providing for codification; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.
