

An Act relating to public health and safety; creating the Oklahoma Self-Directed Care Act; providing short title; stating legislative findings and intent; directing the Oklahoma Health Care Authority to establish certain care program and to implement such program upon federal approval; requiring interagency cooperative agreements; allowing choice of provider and direction of service delivery; providing for enrollment of specified persons; defining terms; providing program parameters and consumer responsibility, specifying roles and responsibilities of agencies and the fiscal intermediary; providing for certain reimbursement; specifying employment criteria for specified purposes; providing for promulgation of rules and necessary waiver applications; providing for compliance with federal regulations; requiring program review by agencies; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.
