

An Act relating to mineral interests; amending 60 O.S. 2001, Section 658.1, which relates to the disposition of certain mineral interests; providing for certain abandoned mineral interests to be sold after a certain period of time; providing for certain legal descriptions and property information to be confidential; requiring the State Treasurer to send certain report to county clerk; amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 271, which relates to property subject to escheat; providing exception for certain mineral interests; amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 271.1, which relates to abandoned mineral interests; providing for certain mineral interests to be subject to judicial sale after certain time period; stating procedures for sale; removing ability of certain interested parties to bring certain action; amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 273, which relates to sale of certain vested property; providing procedures for certain properties to be sold by the Attorney General or district attorney; amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 274, as amended by Section 1, Chapter 29, O.S.L. 2003 (84 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 274), which relates to publishing of certain notice; requiring district attorney to send certain notice to the Attorney General; amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 275, which relates to persons claiming interest in certain property; removing provision for compensation for certain persons bringing information relating to property; and amending 84 O.S. 2001, Section 276, which relates to sale of certain unclaimed property; modifying procedure for sale of certain abandoned minerals subject to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act; and declaring an emergency.
