AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to education; making appropriations to the State Board of Education; stating purposes; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Certified Employee Health Benefit Allowance.

SECTION 2. There is hereby appropriated to the State Board of Education from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2004, the sum of _____ Dollars (\$0.00) or so much thereof as may be necessary for the Support Personnel Health Benefit Allowance.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
