AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to the Oklahoma Tax Commission; making an appropriation; stating purpose; making appropriation exempt from certain category and budget limits; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. There is hereby appropriated to the Oklahoma Tax Commission from any monies not otherwise appropriated from the General Revenue Fund of the State Treasury for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the sum of \_\_\_\_\_ Dollars (\$\_\_\_ ) or so much thereof as may be necessary to perform the duties imposed upon the Oklahoma Tax Commission by law.

SECTION 2. The appropriation made by this act shall not be subject to fiscal year 2006 agency category and budget limits.

SECTION 3. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 4. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
