AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to public health and safety; amending 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2-331, which requires peace officers to provide notice to the Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs upon the seizure of certain chemicals; clarifying language; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY 63 O.S. 2001, Section 2-331, is amended to read as follows:

Section 2-331. It shall be the duty of any peace officer of the State of Oklahoma who seizes any glassware, instruments, devices, utensils or precursor chemicals, as defined by Section 2-322 of ~~Title 63 of the Oklahoma Statutes~~ this title, which have been used or were intended ~~to be used~~ for use in the illicit manufacturing of any controlled dangerous substance, in full or in part, to make notice of the seizure in writing to the Oklahoma Bureau of Narcotics and Dangerous Drugs Control.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2006.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby

declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
