HOUSE BILL 1222

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to rural fire departments; providing amount of operational grants to rural fire departments for certain fiscal year; providing for amount of grant notwithstanding conflicting provisions; providing for noncodification; providing an effective date; and declaring an emergency.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law not to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes reads as follows:

Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2006, the operational grants for rural fire departments made by appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry, shall be Three Thousand Dollars (\$3,000.00) per department.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective July 1, 2005.

SECTION 3. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
