HOUSE BILL 1243

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to firearms; amending Section 1, Chapter 39, O.S.L. 2004 (21 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 1289.7a), which relates to transporting or storing firearms in locked vehicles; exempting certain persons and entities from civil liability for the storage of firearms in locked vehicles; providing exception; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. AMENDATORY Section 1, Chapter 39, O.S.L. 2004 (21 O.S. Supp. 2004, Section 1289.7a), is amended to read as follows:

Section 1289.7a A. No person, property owner, tenant, employer, or business entity shall be permitted to establish any policy or rule that has the effect of prohibiting any person, except a convicted felon, from transporting and storing firearms in a locked vehicle on any property set aside for any vehicle.

B. No person, property owner, tenant, employer, or business entity shall be liable in any civil action for occurrences which result from the storing of firearms in a locked vehicle on any property set aside for any vehicle, unless the person, property owner, tenant, employer, or owner of the business entity commits a criminal act involving the use of the firearms.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
