HOUSE BILL 1310

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to roads, bridges and ferries; designating certain bridge as the Rider Daugherty Memorial Bridge; directing placement of markers; providing for codification; and declaring an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 1674 of Title 69, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The bridge crossing Little Lee Creek, which is located on State Highway 101, shall be designated as the "Rider Daugherty Memorial Bridge". The Department of Transportation shall cause suitable permanent markers to be placed upon the bridge bearing that name.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
