HOUSE BILL 1392

AS INTRODUCED

An Act relating to state government; requiring state agencies to consider certain factors when deciding to purchase or lease real property for certain purposes; providing for codification; and providing an effective date.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 94.1 of Title 74, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

When a state agency is purchasing or leasing real property for the purpose of obtaining office space in a municipality with a population of less than ten thousand (10,000) persons according to the latest Federal Decennial Census, the state agency shall first consider locating in the downtown area of the municipality taking into consideration costs and any incentives the municipality may offer to the state agency to locate in the downtown area of the municipality.

SECTION 2. This act shall become effective November 1, 2005.
